**Graded races:**

Graded races are available on 16<sup>th</sup> of June. Entry fee €15/110DKK in class 1-2 and €10/75DKK in class 3-5.

Entries to graded races close Wednesday evening for dogs eliminated in the semi-finals and Monday 19:00 for dogs not entered into the CGRC races.

**Practical information:**

Camping at the track is available for free.

Only CGRC approved muzzles that do not affect photo finish are allowed. E.g. Australian and English/Irish type wire muzzles or plastic coated wire muzzles are allowed, while American type "box" muzzles are not.

All dogs have to be present at the track from one hour before first race to 15 minutes after last race.

Races start at 18:00 CEST on Wednesday and 16:00 CEST on Saturday.

**Additional information:**

10, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 points awarded towards European Tour winner 2018 in each of the CGRC Classics finals. One greyhound and one whippet is declared European Tour winner at the end of the season.
